1. Council File No. 15,879, Pending File Ordinance 25-2014
An ordinance appropriating the sum of **\$790,000.00** in the City of Erie 2011 Capital Bond Fund from unanticipated and unappropriated fund balance.

1. Council File No. 15,881
An ordinance amending the Codified Ordinances of the City of Erie Part One- Administrative Code, Title Seven-Employment Provisions, Pensions, Article 145. Officers and Employees' Retirement System by amending Sections 145.02 and 145.15 (f) by adding a definition relating to "Surviving Spouse," and amending the definition of Survivor," and amending the provision regarding Anti-Alienation in order to clarify the status of former spouses under the Plan.
