Mayor Sinnott to be Sworn in for Second Term

ERIE, PA (December 29, 2009) At noon Monday, January 4th, Joseph E. Sinnott will be sworn in for his second term as Mayor of the City of Erie. Christopher J. Sinnott, Esq., brother of the Mayor, will be the Master of Ceremonies and the official Oath of Office will be administered by The Honorable Francis J. Fornelli, President Judge, Court of Common Pleas, Mercer County, and Uncle of the Mayor.

The ceremony will include an invocation by the Very Reverend John J. Detisch, Pastor of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, remarks by Rabbi Leonard Lifshen, D.D., Congregation Brith Shalom and a benediction from the Reverend Doctor Gary Brown, Sr. a long-time friend and supporter of Mayor Sinnott.
