### **City of Erie 2010 Property Taxes**

Erie, PA—City Treasurer Susan E. DiVecchio, would like to notify City of Erie Taxpayers, that the 2010 Property Taxes are in the mail.

The school tax bill reflects the homestead exclusion which has been provided under the Pa. Taxpayer Relief Act.

There is information printed on the front and back of the 2010 tax bills, so please review each bill thoroughly.

If your taxes are escrowed, the property owners should mail them to their mortgage company. If anyone does not receive their tax bills by the end of January, please call our office at 870-1210. The office is open from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. weekdays.

This year you will be able to pay your Property Taxes online at the City of Erie's Website [www.erie.pa.us](http://www.erie.pa.us). We are also be accepting VISA and MASTERCARD in the office or on line where a convenience fee is added on to your bill.
