2011 Dog License Renewal Notices to be Mailed

ERIE, PA (November 9, 2010) – In an effort to streamline the Dog License Renewal process, the City of Erie will mail renewal applications this week to all households currently issued a 2010 Dog License. Owners can easily update information as necessary and return the renewal application, along with payment and a self addressed stamped envelope to: City of Erie Dog License Renewal 626 State Street – Room 105 Erie, PA 16501. The database will be updated and tags mailed out immediately.

Canines 3 months and older are required to be licensed in the City of Erie. This is for the safety and security of the animal, in the event a resident's pet or service animal becomes lost or stolen, to get them back home to their owners as quickly as possible. New and renewal licenses will also be available, for purchase at the A.N.N.A Shelter - 1555 East 10th Street, Nickel Plate Mills – 1932 Parade Street (\$2.00 handling fee added) and Grooming by Charlene – 1712 West 8th Street (\$2.00 handling fee added).

The license fee has remained the same, \$8.00 for animals that are not spayed/neutered, and \$6.00 for spayed/neutered animals. Discounts do apply for owners over 65 years of age and those with disabilities. We anticipate City of Erie residents will find this procedure most helpful in maintaining a safe community as well as for the safety of their animals.
