National Prescription Drug Take Back Day

(ERIE, PA – September 9, 2015) The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has scheduled its final **National Prescription Drug Take Back Day** for this **Saturday, September 12, 2015**, from **10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

The front lobby of City Hall will again serve as one of many collection sites within Erie County on that date. The service is free and anonymous, no questions asked. (Needles and other sharps will not be accepted in this collection.)

Immediately after Saturday's event, the DEA will collect all materials from each drop-off site for incineration. **No medications will be collected by the City of Erie Police Department or Sergeant Tuznik after Saturday's event.**

After Saturday's event, residents looking to safely discard unused, unwanted or expired medication can visit any of the permanent drop box locations in Erie County listed below:
