The purpose of these public hearings is to:

1. Obtain the views and comments of individuals and organizations concerning the City's housing and community and economic development needs. The information gathered will be used in the preparation of the City's Five Year Consolidated Plan for the Fiscal Years 2015-2019 and the FY2010 Annual Action Plan for the use of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds, HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME) funds and Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds.
2. Summarize the Consolidated Planning process, schedule and to obtain the views of citizens, public agencies and others interested in the housing and community development needs of the City.

The City is also soliciting applications from interested organizations and community groups in Erie for eligible activities and projects within the City. All activities and projects must benefit low- and moderate-income persons.
